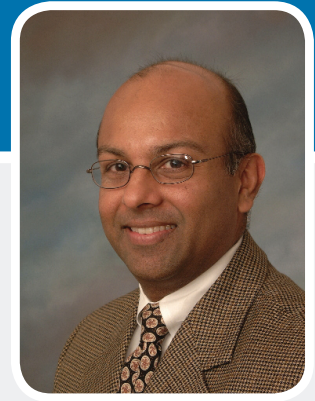

Regeneron VGFT-OD-0605: a randomized, double masked, active controlled Phase III study of the efficacy safety and tolerability of repeated doses of intravitreal VEGF trap in subjects with Neovascular Age-related Macular Degeneration.

Genentech FVF4165g: a Phase III, multicenter, randomized, sham injection controlled study of the efficacy and safety of Ranibizumab injection compared with sham in subjects with Macular Edema secondary to Branch Retinal Vein Occlusion.

Allergan 206207-012-00: A 52-week, masked, multicenter, randomized, controlled trial (with up to 13 weeks additional follow-up) to assess the safety and efficacy of 700 ug Dexamethasone posterior segment drug delivery system (DEX PS DDS) applicator system in combination with laser photocoagulation compared with laser photocoagulation alone in the treatment of subjects with diffuse Diabetic Macular Edema (DME).

Allergan Posurdex 206207-018: A 26 week, open-label study to assess the safety and efficacy of 700 ug Dexamethasone posterior segment drug delivery system applicator system in the treatment of vitrectomized subjects with Diabetic Macular Edema.
